- Town approval complete
- The playground estimate (\$58k structure) total is \$85k, quoted \$30k installation and surfacing
- Discussed fundraising vs pause/phase in options. To phase in or pause until all fundraising is complete or to finish the project at one time, one big fundraising push to reach goal amount
